

Identify a Mentor

Generally, a prospective planter should identify a mentor connected to their sending (home) church. Cultivate will provide simple, easy to use resources to ensure the mentor can effectively train the prospective planter. The training generally requires no more than two hours per week, and can be completed in 6-24 months depending on the planter's experience. If the planter is unable to identify a mentor at their home church, or at a Calvary Chapel or like-minded church near the area where they want to plant, then Cultivate can provide assistance. Mentors will discover the benefits to the home church and the Kingdom which training and sending church planters creates.



There is a clear and concise description of the expectations for the planter and mentor at the beginning of the manual. Evaluate

Cultivate's Robust Theological Assessment

Our proprietary comprehensive theological assessment will provide the planter and mentor precious insights to discern theological training needs that can be addressed by the mentor and developed through our Equipping resources. Access is provided to mentors and planters participating in Cultivate.

Church Planter Candidate Assessment (CPCA)

Lifeway's CPCA provides a 360° perspective of the planter's areas of proficiency, and areas that need to be strengthened through training and/or team development. This resource is vital to any church planter and can be accessed by participants in Cultivate (Lifeway charges a small fee to utilize).

APEST Assessment

This personal vocational assessment helps the planter discover their ministry style in relation to the five-fold ministry laid out in Ephesians 4 (apostolic, prophetic, evangelistic, shepherding, and teaching): https://www.theforgottenways.org/what-is-apest.aspx

Post-Launch Support

During the *first* year, we strongly encourage mentors to meet with planters on a monthly basis. If possible, these meetings should be in-person, but if logistics are an obstacle, then we encourage at least one in-person meeting during the first year. In the *second* year we advocate meeting at least once per quarter, and we highly recommend at least one in-person meeting.

Funding

You do not need a massive budget to be an effective church planter (money is not the key). Nevertheless, financial support can be helpful. Cultivate can help the sending church provide funding through a purchase order (PO) system and can educate planters about fundraising and support in coordination with their sending church.
